There are five different packets that are contained in these computers. The packets range from \$23 to \$65. Each contains a certain amount of faces of all the games. They include the jackpot and early and late birds.

The procedure is to go to the entrance counter and buy your packet where you

receive your computer card. You take this card to Merle next to the concession stand where he programs your purchase into one of the computer modules.

They are very easy to operate and Merle will gladly explain the operation for you. He is also there for the entire game to help you with any problems that you may encounter during the night.

The computers are provided to us by Lancaster Bingo Company that is based locally out of the Rochester area. Merle is an employee of that company and LBC accepts all responsibility for the rental and the maintenance and training for the machines.

WHERE DOES IT ALL GO??

I just wanted to take this opportunity to thank you all for your continued support of the programs that Barons Bingo supports.

Spectrum Winter Colorguard is made up of young people between the ages of 14-22. There is no school sponsor and the guard depends entirely on bingo and the fund raising that they do to fund the group. Did you know that we have to rent gyms for them to practice in at the tune of \$30 per hour? We also rent vans to transport them and their uniforms and flags etc.....a usual weekend trip costs about \$550 for the van rentals and fuel. We also help pay for the uniforms, flags, rifles, sabers etc that they need. The vinyl tarp that they put down on the floor to protect the gym floor costs \$2000 to buy a new one.

Scholarship program-we donate money so that music students can attend music camps in the summer. We also provide our members with scholarships to the college that they attend. We give them \$50 for every year that they have been members. It is paid directly to the school that they are attending.

We also make donations to other groups around the area. We have made donations to the Memorial Day Parade and to several other charitable groups as well.

Our expenses to run the game are for example: \$170 per week to rent the Gibson Fire Hall for Bingo. We are in the process of buying new tables at \$90 per table, we are negotiating for a new bingo verifier (still a little scared about the price of that), our normal paper supplies, the fees that get paid to the town for licensing etc and just general expenses.

Look for a very new group that we will be supporting in the near future also!

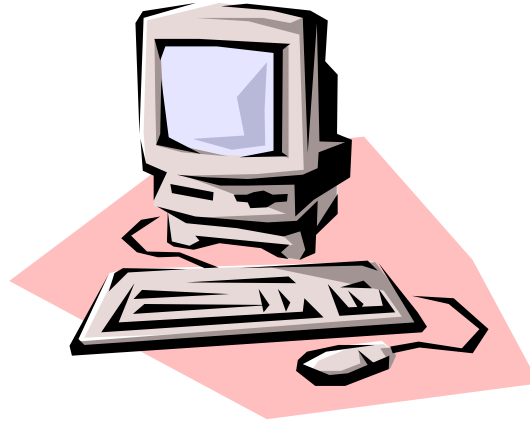
The Barons Parents Associations has a Bingo website on the web! We would like to invite you to check it out at www.spectrumbingo.homestead.com.
